
Sean Cavanaugh's ripoff outfit FontSite

A brief report for legal authorities by Ulrich Stiehl, Heidelberg 2008


Sean Cavanaugh (see http://www.fontsite.com/about) who lives in San Diego (USA) and runs the ripoff outfit FontSite Inc. falsely claims to be "copyright owner" and "trademark owner" of the ripoff font stuff sold by Martin Kotulla in Nürnberg (Germany).

Example: "Bergamo" alias "Bemtus" alias "Bembo"






Martin Kotulla coined the name (his "trademark") Bergamo for this Bembo ripoff in 1993 ("4/16/1993").




Years later, Sean Cavanaugh started selling Martin Kotulla's ripoff stuff cheating dimwitted font buyers by pretending to be the "copyright owner" of the ripped-off fonts ("Copyright by FontSite Inc.").

Font buyers are natural born dimwits and can be easily cheated. So it was easy for Cavanaugh to also make these dimwits believe his false claim that FontSite is the "owner" of the "trademark" **Bergamo**. ("Bergamo is a trademark of FontSite Inc.")

Both fonts are glyph-identical, i.e. Sean Cavanaugh's "Bergamo" is a ripoff of Martin Kotulla's ripoff. This means the ripoff font stuff sold by Sean Cavanaugh is a ripoff of the ripoff sold by Martin Kotulla.

Via EULA, confidence trickster Sean Cavanaugh claims to be the "copyright owner" of the ripoff stuff ripped off by the FontSite ripoff outfit (see http://www.fontsite.com/purchase-info/eula-free-fonts).
